To God's beloved at Immanuel,

The book of Mistakes by Corinna Luyken - is a playful story which shows readers that even the biggest "mistakes" can be redeemed. Not just "fixed," but redeemed, made into something new and beautiful that couldn't have been dreamed had the mistake never been made.

One by Kathryn Otoshi - is a story about what happens to us and to our relationships when we give into our basest human impulses and how together, in community, we can build each other up and help one another to be the best, most authentic versions of ourselves.

The Rabbit Listened by Cori Doerrfeld - is a sweet story about how to be loving and compassionate toward the people in our lives, being quick to listen and slower to speak.

Words and Your Heart by Kate Jane Neal - is a story about our hearts (the little bit inside of you that makes you, you!) and how the words that we speak and the words we listen to can affect how we feel and act. What would it be like if the words we listened most closely to were the words of God?

I Have a Little Problem, Said the Bear by Heinz Janisch - is a lovely story about living together in community and caring for the needs of others.

I hope you will join us in faithful community and worship this blessed season.






